- Welcome and Introductions
  - Ralene called the meeting to order. We went around the table. 13 were present.
  
- Approval of Minutes
  - Susan read them. Carole motioned to approve them and Jason seconded it. They were approved.
  
- ASB Student Leaders
  - Fundraisers
    - Freshman made \$27 with an ice cream sundae bar at the football game on September 26<sup>th</sup>.
    - Sophomores made \$114 with a bake sale at the football game and another \$50 at the flea market.
    - Juniors made about \$50 selling bracelets at the football game.
    - ASB has made posters with announcements for sports.
