November 4, 2015

- Welcome and Introductions
 - Ralene called the meeting to order. We went around the room and introduced ourselves. Thirteen were present.
 - Jackie motioned to approve the minutes and Jason seconded them. All were in favor.
- Treasurers Report
 - We have an ending balance of \$13,159.27.
 - The flea market is doing well. It profited \$1,066.80. in October.
 - The Pizza My Heart fundraiser made \$349.08.
 - Spirit wear made \$145 in October.
- Athletic Directors/Administrators Report
 - Seasons are overlapping right now. Fall sports are finishing up and tryouts have started for winter sports.
 - A girl's single and a double team moved on to try to qualify for CCS today.
 - Girls cross country won league champion. The boy's team also qualified for CCS. They both have been doing well.
 - Volleyball has one more match.
 - Field hockey has one more game. They are still hoping to qualify for CCS.
 - Football has two more games: one home and one away.
 - Basketball and soccer tryouts for girls and boys are starting up as well as tryouts for wrestling.
 - Gatorade came out to talk to athletes about hydration when working out and they brought products with them. They will come out every year.
- Membership

- Presidents Report
