

# Panther Paws Board Meeting

## October 7, 2015

- Welcome and Introductions
  - Jason Potmesil called the meeting to order and we went round the table doing introductions. Thirteen were present.
  - Thomas Swidler moved to approve the minutes and Jason seconded it. All were in favor.
- Treasurers Report
  - We have an ending balance of \$11,066.91, but we will have to give 40% of the memberships to ASB.
  - We made \$275 with the ewaste event, but have not received the check yet.
  - We made \$290 at the Pizza My Heart Night and are waiting for the check.
  - We made \$58 with the Kona Ice food truck and will get the check soon.
  - We will continue to book more restaurant nights and another ewaste event for the spring.
  - We are also organizing an event at Sports Basement in Campbell.
- Membership Report
  - We have gotten maybe 5-8 new memberships since last month.
  - We did not have the most current count for this meeting.
- Athletic Directors/Administrators Report
  - Tennis is doing very well right now. They are at 8-1 for the season.
  - Field Hockey has 2 wins and 2 losses for the season.
  - Football is struggling. We are hoping for a better week this week.
  - Cross Country has some strong runners individually and they are doing well as a team. They did have to skip some games because of the heat. They will be made up.
  - Volleyball is having a tough season and have lost Senior players from last year. They are a young team. JV Volleyball is undefeated.
  - We are starting conditioning for winter sports this week. Tryouts will begin November 2<sup>nd</sup> for winter sports.
  - Around 300 students are participating in fall sports.
  - Jason will email a list of items bought for teams last year to Thomas Swidler to be posted on the website. We are hoping that having it posted will encourage more donations and memberships.
- Flea Market
  - The flea market made about \$800 in September.
  - The next flea market will be on October 24<sup>th</sup>.
  - Volleyball and tennis are the teams that will be helping in October.
